AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2014 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of \$12,500.00. This is a donation from the Century Fund to the City to continue Public Art restoration and Public Art signage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2014 General Fund in the amount of \$12,500.00 reflecting receipt of monies from the Century Fund for the purpose of public art restoration and signage.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Office of the Mayor as follows:

000-01-0201-0001-50 (Other Services and Charges) \$12,500.00

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
