AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2015 Grant Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of \$404,667 as a result of an Environmental Protection Agency Grant, for the Community Department to provide for Brownfields funds for a remediation Allentown Metalwork project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2015 Grant Fund in the amount of \$404,667 reflecting receipt of monies from EPA, Brownfields grant for remediation of Allentown Metalworks.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Grant Fund to the Community Department contract services program as follows:

SECTION THREE: That by an affirmative vote of six Councilpersons the 14 day period between introduction and final passage is hereby eliminated.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.
