AN ORDINANCE

Amending Article 539, Street Cleaning, by extending the perimeters of District 3 to run from 17th Street to Ott Street (rather than ending at 23rd Street).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That Article 539.02, Control Maps and Preparation, is amended to include the following extension:

539.02 Control Maps and Preparation

District #3: 17th St to 23rd Ott, MLK north to Tilghman.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
