AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2016 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$13,789.79) from the Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania Office Of The State Fire Commissioner Grant, to the Allentown Fire Department to provide for Fire Department Training Equipment to be used at the Training Academy.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2016 General Fund in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$13,789.79) reflecting receipt of monies from a the Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania Office Of The State Fire Commissioner grant to purchase Fire Training Equipment.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Fire Department budget as follows:

The Allentown Fire Department was awarded a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Office Of The State Fire Commissioner grant to purchase Fire Training Equipment.
