AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2009 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Two (\$4,882) Dollars to provide for the receipt of a grant from the PA Council of the Arts to support the City's summer concert series.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase of Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Two (\$4,882) Dollars to the unappropriated balance of the General Fund Budget to provide funding to support the City's summer concert series.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:


