AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2008 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars to provide for the receipt of a grant from the Pennsylvania Community Revitalization Assistance Program. This grant is *for the support of the revitalization of Cedar Creek Parkway.*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars increase to the unappropriated balance of the capital budget for Cedar Creek Parkway capitol project.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

Cedar Creek Parkway Capitol:

Other Contract Services: 001-08-1638-0810-68 \$ 5,000

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
