AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2008 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-eight (\$4,888) Dollars to provide for the receipt of a grant from the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts. This grant is *for the support of the City's Summer Concert Series and Art in the Park.*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a Four Thousand eight Hundred and Eighty-eight (\$4,888) Dollar increase to the unappropriated balance of the General Fund.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

Organized Sports Activities:

Other Contract Services: 000-08-0905-0002-46 \$ 4,888

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
