ORDINANCE

Amending the 2008 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Seventy-five Thousand (\$75,000) Dollars in Main Street funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to provide funding to implement the *Main Street Program* along Seventh Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the amount of Seventy Five Thousand (\$75,000) Dollars, reflecting receipt of Main Street Program operating and facade grants funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for the purpose of implementing the Main Street Program along the North Seventh Street corridor.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Comprehensive Planning Program in the Bureau of Planning and Zoning, in the following amounts to the following accounts:

Ordinance: Recognizing Main Street Grant Revenues and Expenses

- What Department or bureau is Bill originating from? Where did the initiative for the bill originate?

Bill Origination: Bureau of Planning and Zoning, Department of Community and Economic Development

Initiative: Seventh Street Main Street Program

- Summary and Facts of the Bill:

This ordinance recognizes the revenue and expenses from a grant received from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for operating the Seventh Street Main Street program. The grant includes \$45,000 for operating and \$30,000 façade grants. These funds are matched with \$15,000 raised by CACLV from several sources.
