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AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2009 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of One Hundred and Eighty-Four Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty-Four Dollars and Three Cents (\$184,664.03), from the Parks and Recreation, Capital Fund, Arts Park Development, to Community and Economic Development Capital Fund, Art District Enhancements, for improvements, renovations and feasibility studies pertaining to the Arts District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the Capital Project Fund in the amount of One Hundred and Eighty-Four Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty-Four Dollars and Three Cents (\$184,664.03), reflecting a transfer as noted below

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund, in the following amounts to the following accounts:
