AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2009 General Fund to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty (\$12,750) Dollars; to provide for the grant from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency to the City of Allentown for Weed and Seed Quality of Life.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty (\$12,750) Dollar increase to the General Fund.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:
