AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance providing for the expenditure of certain monies received by the City of Allentown under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; for the purpose of undertaking programs of housing and community development within the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the Mayor is authorized to expend Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars in Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) funds for the July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 grant year, for housing and community development programs pursuant to the approved Consolidated Plan, appropriate Federal Law and United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations.

SECTION TWO: That the Mayor is directed to establish and maintain any and all accounts and records as are necessary and to make such transfers as may be required to expend and account for said CDBG in accordance with the approved Consolidated Plan, appropriate Federal law, and HUD regulations.

SECTION THREE: That this act of the Council of the City of Allentown is undertaken pursuant to Act 292 of 1974 in accordance with the opinion of the Pennsylvania Attorney General (Opinion 72-75) which holds that CDBG Funds are General Municipal Funds for the purpose of Act 292 of 1974.

SECTION FOUR: That, in accordance with the Action Plan, the Council of the City of Allentown authorizes the appropriation of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars in the following manner:

PUBLIC SERVICES (CDBG)

700-01-7702-0108 Communities In Schools.....15,000

SECTION FIVE: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
