AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2011 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$548.70) and seventy cents. This reflects reimbursement from the State of Pennsylvania, Office of the Attorney General for training.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2011 General Fund in the amount of five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$548.70) and seventy cents reflecting receipt of monies from a reimbursement from the State of Pennsylvania, Office of the Attorney General for training.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Police Department, training program as follows:
