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AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2012 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) as a result of a grant received by Penn State University for the Weed and Seed Youth Coordinator.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) increase to the General Fund.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

This bill allows receipt of the final payment which will then be passed to Community Action Development Corporation, the fiscal agent for the grant. There have been no down-sides. We have worked effectively with adolescents and their parents.
