AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2011 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplement appropriation of Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500) Dollars to provide for a Penn State University Grant for the Weed and Seed Youth Coordinator.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the amount of Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500) Dollars.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes an appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

The City of Allentown Weed and Seed is a subawardee of Penn State University. Our agreement is for 2008-2011 to deliver 4 Strengthening Family Programs per year. The total dollar amount is \$182,210. The reimbursement of \$9,500 reflects costs associated with year 3 for the salary of the Weed and Seed Youth Coordinator, fringe benefits and training expenses.
