A Message From Our Patrol Area Captain

Hello Neighbors,

I just wanted to take a few moments and talk about some of the issues in PSA 4 and the northern section of our PSA. Summer is here and we are again experiencing those Quality of Life issues that seem to always surface as the weather heats up. Loud music, loud people and parties, littering and loitering. Etc.

I have informed the officers in our PSA to enforce these violations with citations and Disruptive Conduct Reports for rental properties. When you call, if you know, please inform the dispatcher that the address in question is a rental and you are requesting a DCR report.

Recently, I spoke with Kim Beitler about some of the issues in this area of our PSA. We felt that some are reluctant to call to report issues for fear of retaliation or lack of confidence. Some would like some closure or information as to what happened on something that they did call about. I have created an email address for our PSA. You can send information on something you would like to report. I can then respond to you by email, both acknowledging that I got your email and then can send back an email informing you as to what we are doing or have done on the issue. I am working on ways to increase uniformed officers on walking patrols in the northern part of the city. Please send me feedback if you see them and your interaction with the officers. Please feel free to approach them and talk to them. They are your police officers. Let them know you are glad to see them, tell them what is happening in your block.

One last word for this newsletter. We are experiencing an increase in burglaries and some street robberies. Please take a moment to ensure your house is secured. Even if you are just going to be away for a moment or two. If sitting on your front porch, be sure the back is locked. Call the police if you see something or someone you feel is suspicious. You know your neighborhood better than anyone.

For the next newsletter, I will report on some of the crime statistics for our neighborhood, results on some of the initiatives I touched on and the Department's COMPSAT process.

If you see properties anywhere in the City of Allentown (even though they may not be your property) with graffiti on them, please report it to 610-437-8729 to put it on the list for removal. So much graffiti is going up we need everyone to do their part to make sure it gets reported and removed ASAP.
