MARCH MEETING MINUTES

- Attendance: 4 members, & 1 police officer.
- Captain Hendricks mentioned his retirement at the end of 2013, as well as 15 other officers. Captain Hendricks is a candidate for Allentown City Council.
- At the February meeting, it was stated that Grace Lutheran Church at St. John & Hall Streets is in NEED of people helping out with a truck for the food bank. The person or persons would have to go to the Second Harvest Food Bank with their truck on the second Wednesday and Friday between 1:30-2:00 to pick up food and deliver it to Grace Lutheran Church.
- Captain Hendricks told us that Basin Street is the deadliest street in Allentown. There are several proposals to address the safety of this roadway. The transitions strip between the road and the bridge over the Cedar Creek has been milled to remove the bump. That appears to have diminished the number of accidents. One proposal is to reduce Basin Street to one lane in each direction. Another is where to narrow the southbound lanes for Harrison St. There will be public meetings on these proposals.

YELLOW DOT PROGRAM
