## MARCH MEETING MINUTES

- Attendance- 11 members, 1 police officers.
- Captain Daryl Hendricks reported that the police department continues to increase in size. PennDot has requested that Allentown install cameras on both ends of the 8<sup>th</sup> St. Bridge. This expansion would allow more cameras to be installed in our area. Police officers are doing more business checks and walking patrols city wide and in our neighborhood.
- Allentown Police did a roving DUI patrol on March 13-14. Seven motorists were arrested.
- Ken provided a Disruptive Conduct Report for 2008 in which 634 DCR's were filed, a decrease of 150 from 2007. Noise complaint is the top DCR complaint. The DCR Appeals board heard 41 appeals in which 7 were granted. 12 of these appeals were for a third DCR, which means the tenant has to be evicted. Only one of these appeals were granted.
- Members reported some issues. Capt. Hendricks and Ken will research the issues.
