NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES

- Attendance- 13 members, 2 police officers.
- Captain Daryl Hendricks introduced Officer Joshua Faust. Officer Faust is one of our new police officers.
- Captain Hendricks reported that the "Special Operations" assignment will continue. The officers on this assignment usually do not respond to routine calls. They are on duty during high crime hours and search for trouble-makers. It also has been used when the high schools dismiss. They respond to fights and prevent the students from loitering.
- Ken asked about the number of school age children seen on the streets during school hours. Captain Hendricks stated that a daytime curfew exists in the city. If you see a school age child outside, report it to the non-emergency number 610-437-7751.

SNOW REMOVAL

Property owners have 10 hours after snow or sleet have stopped falling to clear a *three-foot wide path* on the sidewalk. There is a \$600 fine for each day after the ten-hour period that the sidewalk has not been cleared.
