NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES

SHADE TREE COMMISSION

The Allentown Shade Tree Commission has expressed an interest in planting shade trees along S. 8th St. and St. John Streets. This is a subject that we need to discuss before we give our approval. While I am sure many of us would like the trees along these streets, I believe there has to be a Memorandum of Understanding between the property owners and the Shade Tree Commission concerning responsibilities.

SNOW REMOVAL

Property owners have 10 hours after snow or sleet has stopped falling to clear a *three-foot wide path* on the sidewalk. There is a \$600 fine for each day after the ten-hour period that the sidewalk has not been cleared. ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE
