NOISE COMPLAINTS

Now that it is getting warmer out, remember that these complaints affect the quality of life in our neighborhood. Construction type noise and use of power equipment can not begin prior to 7:00 AM and must end at 10:00 PM. There is not time limit for any other type of noise including loud music. This can be reported anytime of the day. If the complaint is about a barking dog, the dog must be barking for 10 minutes and the barking must be unprovoked. If the source of the noise is from a rental property, please state so when you make the complaint and also state you want a DCR (disruptive conduct report) filed.
