## MARCH MEETING MINUTES

- Attendance- 13 members, 2 police officers, 1 guest.
- Guest speaker last month was City Councilman Pete Schweyer. He reported that in the past 3 years, Type I & II crimes (the most violent) have decreased by 14%, almost half of the city budget is the police department, & the sale of the Montex property is almost complete. However burglaries have increased. He also reported that the 15<sup>th</sup> St. bridge will be replaced starting in 2011. This is projected to be a two year project. LANTA will not be taking Bicentennial Park. They will still be expanding their facility and be hiring more drivers & mechanics.
- Officer Shawn Boyle attended the meeting with Captain Hendricks.
- Ken stated that signs erected on wire stands or attached to poles and traffic boxes advertising concerts, lawyer services, and such are not legal. We are to remove them, document where each was removed from and give to Recycling for prosecution.
