You can also call 610-437-7160 and I'll drop one off at your house. Fill out the requested informaton and I will forward it to the police dept. They will assign you your own personal number. **PARKING AUTHORITY NEWS:** More neighborhoods are investigating the possibility of establishing a Residential Parking Zone. Several criteria must be met to establish this zone; including ensuring that a percentage of vehicles parked in the neighborhood does not belong to residents of the neighborhood. Another criterion requires that a majority of residents sign a petition supporting the establishment of this zone. Are you moving or preparing some of your items for storage? If you are, and you are planning to utilize a mobile pod-like container that is intended to store your belongings prior to them being moved, please be sure that you are not inadvertently violating the 'unhitched trailer' ordinance. We recently noticed that a resident was utilizing a relatively small trailer from a storage company to store their items while they prepare to move. This trailer then is simply connected to a truck and driven to the new location. This practice is not encouraged as, technically, this vehicle is an unhitched trailer and cannot be left unattended on a City street.
