Apply and become among the thousands of Citizens Helping to Eliminate Crime. All you need to do , is come to our meeting to get an application .You can also call 610-437-7160 and I’ll drop one off at your house. Fill out the requested informaton and I will forward it to the police dept. They will assign you your own personal number. Then when you call the police you just give the chec-mate number to the dispatcher instead of your name.. This also speeds things up.
