

Apply and become among the thousands of Citizens Helping to Eliminate Crime. All you need to do, is come to our meeting to get an application. You can also call 610-437-7160 and I'll drop one off at your house. Fill out the requested informaton and I will forward it to the police dept. They will assign you your own personal number. Then when you call the police you just give the chec-mate number to the dispatcher instead of your name.. This also speeds things up. Don't let fear hinder you from quality of life
