Check-Mate Program

All residents are urged to sign up for the Chec-Mate program. Applications are available upon request at meetings. Applications are forwarded to the Allentown Police Department (APD) and assigned an ID number before it is returned to the resident. The number is used to maintain a resident's confidentiality when calling the APD with a complaint. The caller does not have to give his/her name or address, just provide your Chec-Mate number. The APD has the only access to the cross-reference list and will not reveal personal information.

Keep in Mind Snow Removal Policy for City of Allentown

Snow Shoveling- Property owners have 10 hours after the snow of sleet has stopped falling to clear a 3-foot wide path on the sidewalk. There is a \$600 fine for each day after that ten hour period that the sidewalk has not been cleared.
