LANA's November Meeting

Nineteen persons, including six newcomers, attended LANA's monthly meeting on November 18, 2013 at the Allentown Public Library. We welcomed Ray Knouss and Robert Schmidt from Madison St, Nancy Oberly from S 13th, and Keri and Keli Cameron and Paulette Mahoney from S 10th.

Allentown Police Captain Gail Struss said a burglar has been caught in the West End, and that could be the end of those burglaries for a while. She emphasized locking cars and garage doors, and in cars, keeping valuable out of sight. When car windows were broken, it was because a valuable – GPS, laptop or purse was in plain sight.

Captain Struss noted that this is the season for robberies. Be aware of your surroundings. If a person acts suspiciously, stay away. Stay in the light when possible, and keep a porch light on at your house for your protection and your neighbors.

Other concerns: Noisy people late at night: Call Police. If they observe the behavior they can write Disruptive Conduct as part of their report. Three DCR's in a year can get a tenant evicted.

Elderly neighbors with mental and physical challenges: Call Lehigh County's Area Agency on Aging to come out and evaluate. 610-782-3034.

Winter Safety

As winter comes, check your smoke alarms. Do you have one for every floor? And every bedroom? If the batteries are a year or more old, it may be time to replace them.

Check your furnace – oil every year, gas furnaces every 3 years.

Be sure your chimney is clear, so you don't have fumes coming back into the house. Best of all, get a carbon monoxide detector!
