SAFETY THROUGH SUPERIOR KNOWLEDGE, LLC

STSK came to our meeting in January - thank you very much for a wonderful talk about Personal Safety.

The most important piece of info. given was about our own Situational Awareness. Keep in mind texting = WHITE level!
WHITE = UNPREPARED - You are unaware of your environment and its inhabitants. **All Attackers look for this state.** You feel secure, whether you are or not. Awareness is switched off. **YELLOW = RELAXED ALERT** - You are cautious and should spend most of the time in this state. You have a 360-degree awareness of danger spots. Threat awareness and relaxed alertness. Awareness is switched on. **ORANGE = SPECIFIC ALERT** - State of threat evaluation. Decision is made to take action. You are in danger: aware of a potential threat. Look for escape, potential weapons and other people. **RED = FIGHT** - You are in conflict. Carry out decision to act made in Code Orange. **Never stand and fight if there is a possibility of fleeing.** When using physical techniques, use appropriate level of force.
