Keep your car locked at all times. Areas throughout the city have been plagued by individuals breaking into vehicles to get change, laptops, cell phones, GPS devices, etc. YOU need to make sure to lock all doors in your home and set your burglar alarm, installing a motion sensor light may also help to deter criminals.

Citizens Helping Eliminate Crime

CHEC-Mate, designed by the Allentown Police Dept. gives Allentown residents a way of calling the police anonymously to report suspicious activity in their neighborhoods.

Request a CHEC-Mate card by calling 610-437-7522 or attend one of our meetings. In 4-6 weeks you will get your card with a number assigned specifically to you. When you call the communications center, you give only your CHEC-Mate number on the card. CHEC-Mate is a confidential way of reporting crime to help make your neighborhood safer! Take extra care to protect yourself, your family and your property. Please report suspicious people, vehicles, or activity to the police. The non-emergency number is 610-437-7751. In an Emergency or Crime in Progress call 911.
