

Summary of Regulations

It is the intention of the City of Allentown to present the Halloween Parade as a fun, family oriented community event.

- Entries that detract from the celebratory nature of the Parade will *NOT* be permitted to participate.
- Parade participants must complete a registration application to enter in the City of Allentown's Halloween Parade. All applications are subject to the sole discretion of the City of Allentown. The City of Allentown is not obligated to provide any applicant with a reason for the denial of any application.
- Applicants are responsible for communicating all rules and regulations to each member of his/her organization, group, company and/or entry.
- The maximum number of entries for any organization, club, group, or individual is three (3), except by special invitation of the Committee.
- Due to safety concerns, the throwing of anything from floats or vehicles in the Parade is not permitted along the Parade route. Items may be handed out by walking participants but must be approved by the Committee beforehand. Any entry violating this regulation will not be permitted to participate in the following year's parade.
- All Parade participants must stay in the line of march. Do not go into the crowd. The Parade route is narrow, many children and adults sit on the curb, and we do not want anyone to be hurt during the Parade. Parade Officials will be located along the Parade route. Officials instructions must be followed at all times. Parade Officials' decisions are final and not subject to review.

Political Activity Guidelines

- All Municipal, County, State and Federal elected officials may ride or walk in the parade.
- Any candidate seeking election may participate in the parade but **MUST** fill out the proper registration information.
- The Republican and Democratic parties will be allowed to identify themselves. A party float would be allowed, however no candidates may be mentioned.
- Anyone wishing to pass out information or souvenirs on behalf of any candidate will be restricted to sidewalks adjacent to the parade. No pass outs are allowed into or from the parade.
