Permit contingent upon compliance with all Campfire Regulations

Allentown Fire Department Campfire Permit Regulations

Permit is contingent upon the compliance of the following conditions.

The City of Allentown regulations on a specific type of outdoor burning. Campfires require a permit and inspection before lighting. The fire may be in a n approved open container or on the ground. A maximum of one (1) burning permit is allowed per month, per property unless authorized by the Fire Chief. Burn time is limited to three (3) hours unless authorized by the Fire Chief. The regulations below must be followed.

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1.	Location of fire to be a minimum of twenty-five (25) feet from any structure.
	Campfires must be kept to campfire-type size. Per code the maximum pile diameter shall be three (3) feet and the imum pile height shall be two (2) feet.
3.	Flammable liquids shall not be used to ignite fire. Tinder to be paper and light wood.
	Dry wood only should be used. No garbage, rubbish, trash, rubber, plastic, leather or petroleum-based material uld be used.
	The person who has authorization to have the campfire or their representative should remain until the fire is totally nguished.
6.	Dry grass must be removed from the burn area or properly protected from ignition such as by wetting down.
7.	Provide a method for extinguishing the fire such as a water hose.
8.	Ignition of the fire may proceed after a permit has been granted and is inspected by a fire official.
9.	The fire official has the authority to cancel the fire under adverse conditions such as heavy winds or dry conditions.
