Interested in becoming a lifeguard? Benefits include resume building, fast-paced working environment, team-oriented job, and interacting with a variety of people while working outside. The City of Allentown Parks and Recreation Department offers a variety of American Red Cross Lifeguarding Classes. Participants must be 15 years of age and able to complete the following pre-requisite skills:

- Complete blended learning video segments
- Swim 300 continuous yards
- Tread Water for 2 minutes
- Complete a timed 10lb brick retrieval from 12 feet of water





Completed Projects

The Urban Greenway:

The Urban Greenway is a two-mile fitness loop, marked by footprints of MeLVin, the Lehigh Valley Phantoms mascot, as well as colorful markers and signage, and artistic benches designed by Allentown School District students. The Urban Greenway was created to encourage and support healthy and active lifestyles, and aimed to connect downtown Allentown with its lush parks and greenspaces.

Hamilton Connector:

This gateway from Hamilton Street to the city's downtown arts district opened in August. The \$1.4 million project includes public art features, performance platforms, new stairways, lighted podiums, new step-style seating and a well-lit welcoming area all cohesively designed with uniform paving and railings. The adjacent parking deck bears a coordinating mural painted on its back wall. The project was funded by ANIZDA, in partnership with the City of Allentown and City Center Investment Corp and continues an effort to connect Hamilton Street to the Arts Walk and enhance the pedestrian experience of downtown Allentown.

Parking Kiosks:

Through funding from ANIZDA and the Allentown Parking Authority a project is underway to replace traditional parking meters with electronic parking kiosks, which accept cash, credit or debit cards, or can be accessed using a Mobile Now App on a smartphone. The new kiosks



also installed along the Hamilton Connector as part of the project.

Upcoming Projects

Bogert's Bridge:

The city was awarded a \$750,000 Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program grant for the rehabilitation of Bogert's Bridge in Lehigh Parkway. It joins an

\$80,000 grant obtained previously from the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission. The total project cost is estimated at just more than \$2 million.

In addition to providing emergency medical services to the residents and visitors of Allentown, our paramedics provide important community





The Allentown Fire Department (AFD) consists of 122 firefighters manning six fire stations with seven engines and one ladder trucks. St. Patrick's Parade & Associated Events

This two-day event is held in August at the Museum of Indian Culture and surrounding areas of Lehigh Parkway and features a large variety of Native American crafters and vendors, in addition to musical and dance performances and youth activities.

India Heritage Festival

Featuring Bollywood style performances, authentic artwork and jewelry, yoga sessions and a variety of vendors and music celebrating Indian culture, this event is typically held during August in the Allentown Arts Park.

Puerto Rican Parade & Festival

This annual parade in July begins on Hamilton Street and showcases the spirit of Puerto Rican culture and pride through city streets, culminating in a musical festival with ethnic food and dance.

Festival Dominicano

Featuring music, food, and entertainment, this festival celebrates many different aspects of the Dominican culture each year in late August.

International Cultural Festival

This event has a broad range of international food and craft vendors and performances and is held in the Allentown Arts Park each September.


West End Theatre District **19th Street from Liberty Street to Tilghman Street**

Dating back nearly 100 years, Civic Theater of Allentown serves as the epicenter and the heart and soul of the district.

More than 150 businesses and shops comprise the district stretching from 17th to 22nd streets and Liberty to Washington streets. And the neighborhood is adjacent to Allentown institutions like the Fairgrounds Farmers Market, Muhlenberg College, Lehigh Valley Hospital and Phoebe Home. The West End Theatre District is overseen by the West End Alliance, a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to the development of the neighborhood.
